### THE COURT MAY ORDER HIV ANTIBODY TESTING FOR THE FOLLOWING INDIVIDUALS:

1. Persons convicted of prostitution [PC 647 (b), 1202.6] or certain other sexual offenses [PC 261, 261.5, 262, 286, 288a, 1202.1].
2. Persons charged with certain sex crimes [PC 261, 261.5, 262, 266c, 286, 288, 288a] (H&S 199.96); or interfering with peace officers. Firefighters or emergency medical workers (H&S 199.97).
3. An inmate, parolee or probationer as requested by the County Health Officer [PC 7510, 7512, 7512.5, 7516].
4. A defendant, as ordered by search warrant, when probable transfer of blood or body fluid to a victim occurred [PC 1524.1].

HIV TESTS CANNOT BE ORDERED FOR PERSONS WHO ARE ORIGINALLY CHARGED WITH ONE OF THESE OFFENSES, BUT LATER HAD THE CHARGE REDUCED TO AN OFFENSE NOT INDICATED ABOVE.
